Autumn 2 – Jump into a Story

Personal, Social & Emotional Development – We will be celebrating differences by learning about different home and families. We will also be thinking about ways to make new friends.

Communication & Language – We will identify sounds in our environment. We will actively retell and recite our favourite rhymes and lines from the stories we read. We will practice asking questions to develop our understanding.

Physical Development – We will be learning to dress ourselves before and after our PE lessons. We will practice balancing along a balance beam and galloping with a leading foot.

Literacy - We will recognise repeated refrains within stories. We will follow patterns of familiar stories and suggest changes to the words e.g. We're Going on a Dog Walk.

Maths – We will use comparison words such as 'big' and 'little' and focus on counting numbers in order. We will practice counting by touching each object as we say the number.

Understanding the World – We will investigate seasonal changes that take place during Autumn and Winter. We will look at shadows and light and talk about firework safety.

Expressive Arts & Design – We will create Christmas artwork, learn Christmas songs with actions and create firework art.
