Spring 1 – Three

7 Areas of Learning:

Personal, Social & Emotional Development – We follow the Jigsaw scheme of Dreams and Goals; and learning about not giving up and persevering. The children will be encouraged to work together either in pairs or as a group to think of ideas relating to the stories.

Communication & Language – The indoor and outdoor role play areas will relate to the stories to encourage story language.

Physical Development – The children will continue to be encouraged to undress and dress themselves promoting independence. They will have the opportunity to use real tools sawing small pieces of wood. We will be developing our balance, agility, and coordination and begin to apply these in a range of activities.

Literacy - We will be exploring new vocabulary from the stories and discuss meaning of new words. The children will learn a new Nursery rhyme each week and new phoneme.

Maths – During our maths lessons we will be comparing groups/quantities. Explore 2D shapes and measuring – length, size, weight, and capacity. Make and break 1, 2 & 3

Understanding the World –Discussing different habitats. We will be testing different construction materials and porridge.

Expressive Arts & Design – We will acting out familiar stories.
