

LKS2 – Year 3 Summer 2 Curriculum Map

English:

In English, the children will start the half-term finishing off their Big Write Adventure stories.

They will then be looking at 'The Firework Maker's Daughter', a book which will link to our Light topic in Science. The children will be learning about the Asian culture and how it is portrayed in the book.

Maths:

In Mathematics, the children will start the term off focusing on Time – looking at Roman numerals, telling the time and digital time.

The children will then look at Angles and Properties of Shapes, focusing on 2D and 3D shapes. They will conclude the term focusing on Statistics, interpreting pictograms and bar charts.

History and Geography:

In Geography, the children will be looking at Europe. They will explore the different countries in Europe and how they have changed over time. They will focus on the significance of the landmarks from the different countries and why they are well known. The children will locate European countries and their major cities on a map, globe and junior atlas and understand why there are similarities and differences between places and draw conclusions between different places.

Overview of topics:

Our Big Write will start off our English lessons. In Mathematics, the main focus will be Time followed by understanding Angles and Shapes.

In Science, we will focus on Light and in Geography, the children will explore Europe.

Computing:

This unit explores the links between events and actions, while consolidating prior learning relating to sequencing.

RE:

In RE, the children will be looking at Christianity. The children will learn about what kind of world did Jesus want and look at events that are significant to the religion.

Science:

In Science, the children will be looking at Light. They will learn about light, reflections and shadows, the different sources of light, and that we need light to see. The children will work scientifically and collaboratively to investigate reflective materials, in the context of designing a new book bag.

PE:

Our PE sessions will take place on a Monday and the lessons will cover a range of fun activities and teaching us about the importance of physical exercise.

Art, Design and Technology, Music:

In Art, the children will be exploring Seurat and Pointillism. They will have an opportunity to create their own art work using pointillism as their main focus.
